### Entry Requirements:

- **Fire 102** - Fire Behavior and Combustion
- **EMS 10** - Emergency Medical Technician
- **FST 106** – Physical fitness prep for the academy

OR a valid **CPAT** certificate

### Estimated Costs:

Approximately **\$1,500** including:

- Tuition & fees \$0
- Books and manuals \$0
- Uniforms (\$800.00)
- PPE/SCBA \$0
- Training Material \$0
- Certification fees (\$590)
  - The Fire District will issue you structural and wildland PPE and SCBA.

### Estimated Costs:

Approximately **\$4,200 to \$5,200**, including:

- Tuition & fees (about \$874)
- Books and manuals (~\$600)
- Uniforms (~\$700–800)
- PPE/SCBA rental and training materials (~\$2,500)
- Certification fees (~\$800–950)

### Schedule:

- You dedicate one 24-hour shift per week and attend a 2-3 day per month academy style weekend for approximately 1-year.
  - Benefits – Hands on experience on an engine running calls, training opportunities, resume builder.

### Schedule:

- **An Academy** typically meets two midweek days such as **Tuesdays** and **Thursdays, from 6pm until 10pm** and all-day Saturday and Sundays for 5-months.
